CONVENTIONAL LOGGERS SAFE WORK PRACTICE

<p>Take part in morning safety talk.</p>		<p>Keep your eyes on the task and Never overextend your reach.</p>
<p>Plan where the tree is going to fall before you cut.</p>		<p>Be aware of your surroundings and always be conscious of Slipping and Tripping hazards.</p>
<p>When bucking a tree, ALWAYS use proper cutting technique to prevent injury.</p>		<p>Be aware of Heat Stress, take breaks to cool down and drink plenty of fluids.</p>
<p>Always wear appropriate PPE when using a chainsaw.</p>		<p>Always carry a personal fire extinguisher and never use a chainsaw not equipped with a spark arrester.</p>
<p>NEVER turn your back on a falling tree.</p>		<p>Always use proper lifting techniques. Use your legs not your back.</p>
<p>Always watch for Danger and Buffer ribbons when cutting trees.</p>		<p>Do your work with pride, put safety in every stride</p>
