

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR SAFETY

CONVENTIONAL LOGGERS SAFE WORK PRACTICE

Take part in morning safety talk.	Keep your eyes on the task and Never overextend your reach.
Plan where the tree is going to fall before you cut.	Be aware of your surroundings and always be conscious of Slipping and Tripping hazards.
When bucking a tree, ALWAYS use proper cutting technique to prevent injury.	Be aware of <u>Heat Stress</u> , take breaks to cool down and drink plenty of fluids.
Always wear appropriate PPE when using a chainsaw.	Always carry a personal fire extinguisher and never use a chainsaw not equiped with a spark arrester.
NEVER turn your back on a falling tree.	Always use proper lifting techniques. Use your legs not your back.
Always watch for Danger and Buffer ribbons when cutting trees.	Do your work with pride, put safety in every stride
