DUMP TRUCK OPERATOR SAFE WORK PRACTICE

<p>Perform walk around inspections before and after each shift.</p>		<p>Ensure all trucks are equipped with first aid kit, fire extinguisher, flares or reflective triangles and a spill kit and inspected regularly.</p>
<p>Always face vehicle and use three point contact when entering or exiting the cab.</p>		<p>Be aware of your surroundings at all times, know what is above, below, and around you</p>
<p>Make sure there are no “Lock out/Tag out” signs posted.</p>		<p>Drive defensively-Obey all traffic laws.</p>
<p>Always wear appropriate PPE and your seatbelt.</p>		<p>It is company policy to call out kilometer location when travelling in or out on Company roads.</p>
<p>The safest place while loading is aboard the Truck</p>		<p>Always be alert when entering traffic, and communicate hazards to others.</p>
<p>Never work under a raised dump unless appropriate blocking is in place first. See SOP</p>		<p>Safety rules are your best tools.</p>
