








# STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR SAFETY

## FORWARDER OPERATOR SAFE WORK PRACTICE

<p>Always perform walk around inspections before and after each shift.</p>		<p>Keep your eyes on the task, and always <b><u>Call in/Call out</u></b> when entering or exiting the cab.</p>
<p>Never operate machine if a <b><u>“Lock out/Tag out”</u></b> sign is posted.</p>		<p>Use shades on sunny days. To avoid glare.</p>
<p>Always face machine and maintain <b><u>three point contact</u></b> when entering or exiting the cab.</p>		<p>Trails straight up hills, or side cut <b><u>NEVER</u></b> forward across hill.</p>
<p>Always wear appropriate <b><u>PPE</u></b> and seatbelt.</p>		<p>Know location of fire extinguishers and spill kit and <b><u>INSPECT THEM REGULARLY.</u></b></p>
<p>Always maintain safe distance from people and vehicles. ⇨ <b>Caution @ Roadside</b></p>		<p>Don't rush Safety, it's <b>your life.</b></p>
