## GRADER OPERATOR SAFE WORK PRACTICE

<p>Take part in morning safety talk</p>		<p>Keep your eyes on the task, and never operate equipment if "Lock out/Tag out" sign is posted.</p>
<p>Always do a circle check of equipment before and after each shift.</p>		<p>Always follow the <b>SOPs</b> (standard operating procedures)</p>
<p>Always face machine and maintain <b>three point contact</b> when entering or exiting the cab.</p>		<p>Always shut down equipment and remove any sources of ignition when refueling, <b>NEVER</b> leave nozzle unattended.</p>
<p>Be familiar with company policy on "<u>Working Alone</u>"</p>		<p>Communicate hazards and road conditions to truckers, contractors, and other company officials.</p>
<p>Always be aware of other traffic in area and always wear your <b>seatbelt</b>.</p>		<p>Always <b>Call in/Call out</b> when entering or exiting equipment.</p>
<p>Always wear appropriate <b>PPE</b></p>		<p>Don't rush Safety it's your <b>life</b></p>
