

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR SAFETY

PRE-COMMERCIAL THINNER SAFE WORK PRACTICE

Always take part in the morning safety chat.	Keep your harness adjusted properly and keep your saw in good working order.
Be aware of your surroundings at all times and be conscious of Slipping and Tripping hazards.	Cut in an organized manner by using a good cutting pattern. Always cut in an uphill direction. It is safer and more productive.
Be aware of Heat Stress , take breaks to cool down and drink plenty of fluids.	Work at a safe speed for the ground and stand conditions. Maintain a safe working distance from other thinners.
Always wear appropriate <u>PPE</u> ,	Always use proper lifting techniques when lifting and carrying your equipment.
Always start your saw at least 3 m away from your refueling location, and always carry your personal fire extinguisher.	Only use <u>CSA approved</u> portable fuel containers.
While filing your blade you must use a file with handle or wear protective gloves.	Work right the first time, safely every time!
