

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR SAFETY

## WOOD LOADER OPERATOR SAFE WORK PRACTICE

Be involved in your pre-shift safety talk.	Always be aware of the location of other equipment and employees working with you, <b>STOP</b> if unsure.
Always perform a walk around inspection before and after each shift.	Always follow Call in/Call out procedures when entering or exiting the cab.
Never operate the machine if a <b>"Lock out/Tag out"</b> sign is posted.	Always shut down equipment and remove any source of ignition when refueling <b>NEVER</b> leave nozzle unattended.
Always wear your <u>PPE</u> and wear your seatbelt.	Know how to activate fire suppression system and location of fire extinuishers, Inspect regularly.
Always face machine and maintain <u>three point contact</u> when entering or exiting your machine.	Keep your eyes on the task, and <u>NEVER</u> load truck if employees are within your danger zone.
Always follow <b>SOPs</b> (standard operating procedures)	Work right the first time, safely every time!
