Summer Safety Tips

As the warm weather approaches, more people are working outside.

Here are some safety tips to keep in mind!

Sun Safety

- Wear sunscreen.
- Wear a hat, sunglasses (CSA approved or 100% UV protection) and appropriate clothing.
- Limit sun exposure when necessary. Seek shade.

Water Safety

- Wear a life jacket.
- Avoid alcohol and drugs when driving a boat.
- Never drive a boat alone.
- Always leave a trip plan with your supervisor.

Heat Safety

- Stay hydrated.
- Stay cool.
- Watch out for symptoms of heat stress, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke.

Fire Safety

- Make sure staff are trained in how to properly extinguish a fire.
- Make sure there is enough fire fighting equipment on site as per OHS legislation.
- Make sure you have an operating permit during fire season.
- Make sure mufflers on all equipment are equipped with spark arrestors.

Other things to keep in mind:

- Make sure you have a proper emergency response plan. Emergency response plan drills should be done at least annually.
- It is important to be certified in first aid training. First aid is crucial to have because you can provide immediate medical attention before paramedics arrive. First aid saves lives.
